Falco Drone Technologies Ltd is developing unique drone technology that allows for drastically improved flight performance of multirotor drones by mimicking bird flight. The technology has the potential to increase flight time from less than one hour (often no more than 20 minutes) to several hours (up to 6 hours in optimal conditions) and increase flight performance in high winds (over 50mph).
